**The Spatial Ecology of Predator-Prey Interactions: A Case Study of Yellowstone Elk, Wolves, and Cougars** Michel T. Kohl, 2019 Predators can serve as an important top-down driver of ecosystems via their influence on prey behavior Although predator effects on prey behavior or traits may be as strong as or stronger than predator effects on prey abundance in small scale experimental systems it is unclear whether behavioral effects are as dominant in large scale free living systems The objective of this project was to improve our ecological understanding of the spatio-temporal interactions between large predators and their primary prey source in a free living system Specifically I used data from northern Yellowstone to evaluate 1 the role of predator diel activity on prey habitat selection of risky places 2 how prey operate in a landscape composed of multiple predators that occupy different spatial and temporal niches and 3 how the density and behaviorally mediated effects of large predators influence the large scale spatial distribution of a prey population In Chapter 2 I show that the predictability of daily

wolf *Canis lupus* hunting activity provided an opportunity for elk *Cervus elaphus* to use risky places during safe times which in essence flattened i.e. minimized the landscape of fear in Yellowstone In Chapter 3 I show that wolves and cougars *Puma concolor* hunt in different places and at different times which provided a refugia from these predators in time and space that likely minimized overall predation risk in an environment that was spatially saturated with wolves and cougars In Chapter 4 I show that the current spatial distribution of elk across the northern range of Yellowstone is driven primarily by demographic rather than behavioral mechanisms Overall the results from chapters 2-4 suggest that any trophic cascade from predators to prey to deciduous woody plants in Yellowstone National Park is likely due to demographic mechanisms rather than a landscape of fear More broadly this research identifies a previously overlooked behavioral trait of predators diel activity which prey can use to minimize the effect of predators on sophisticated prey Together this study advances the field of ecology by quantifying the ecological importance of fear in a large scale free living system

**Predator-Prey Interactions: Co-evolution between Bats and Their Prey** David Steve Jacobs, Anna Bastian, 2017-02-08 This book provides a comprehensive review of the evolution of traits associated with predation and predator defense for bats and all of their prey both invertebrates e.g. insects and vertebrates e.g. frogs in the context of co evolution It reviews current knowledge of how echolocation and passive hearing are used by bats to hunt prey in complete darkness Also it highlights how prey have evolved counter measures to bat echolocation to avoid detection and capture This includes the whole range of prey responses from being active at times when bats are inactive to the use of acoustic signals of their own to interfere with the echolocation system of bats

Weber,2024 Mesocarnivores including bobcats *Lynx rufus* and coyotes *Canis latrans* serve an important ecological role functioning as the top predators throughout much of the eastern United States due to the extirpation of larger bodied carnivores Mesocarnivores are often described as generalists due to their flexibility in forage and habitat preferences and their ability to persist in human dominated landscapes However this characterization overlooks the fact that many individuals within these populations act as specialists with movement space use and predation strategies varying between individuals and across environmental contexts Quantifying variability in mesocarnivore space use and movement from multiple perspectives can provide a better understanding of their ecological function as the current top

predators and their potential influence on white tailed deer *Odocoileus virginianus* populations To better understand how bobcats and coyotes spatially respond to fawn kill sites I leveraged two types of habitat selection functions Resource Selection Functions and Latent Selection Difference Functions to create a framework describing how bobcats coyotes and female white tailed deer respond to fawn kill sites and how these relationships vary with landscape heterogeneity In certain landscape attributes does decreased their use of habitats which were associated with an increased risk of fawn predation Additionally predators were more efficient at killing fawns in certain areas rather than increasing their selection for areas associated with increased fawn risk To evaluate how space use strategies varied across individuals and environmental contexts I also quantified individual and population level variation in space and resource specialization from coyotes located across three disparate environments forest agriculture and urban in Illinois After accounting for the influence of various external and internal factors movement and space use behaviors varied substantially among coyotes within and across populations Given that the integration of movement ecology and animal personality is relatively new my work served as a key first step in determining that behavioral patterns for movement and habitat selection at one scale within a population do not necessarily hold across broader spatial scales across populations Overall I found that evaluating risk and space use from multiple perspectives can provide a deeper understanding of the predator prey spatial game and mesocarnivore space use

**Quantifying Predator-prey Interactions** Pamela E. Moriarty, 2018 Knowledge of predator prey interactions is vital in many subfields of ecology including food web ecology behavioral ecology and population ecology Information on predator prey interactions is obtained from a variety of sources including stomach contents biochemical tracers such as stable isotopes fecal matter and direct observation These data sources are used to infer the predator's diet and each presents analytical and interpretation challenges In this dissertation I pursue research to improve the analysis interpretation and application of varied data sources to study predator prey interactions My first chapter develops a mixture model to increase the accuracy and precision of diet estimates from stomach content data by addressing several challenges inherent to most stomach content datasets I extend this model in my second chapter to address sample interdependence which is a common issue due to sample collection methods My third chapter addresses the challenges of applying stable isotope analysis to jellyfish due to their unique physiology and proposes a path forward to be able to use this data source effectively My fourth chapter predicts the effect of hypoxia a common environmental stressor on energy flow from zooplankton to zooplanktivorous fish by merging multiple data sources in a Bayesian integrated assessment Together my dissertation research identifies and addresses some common challenges of analyzing predator prey interactions

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
