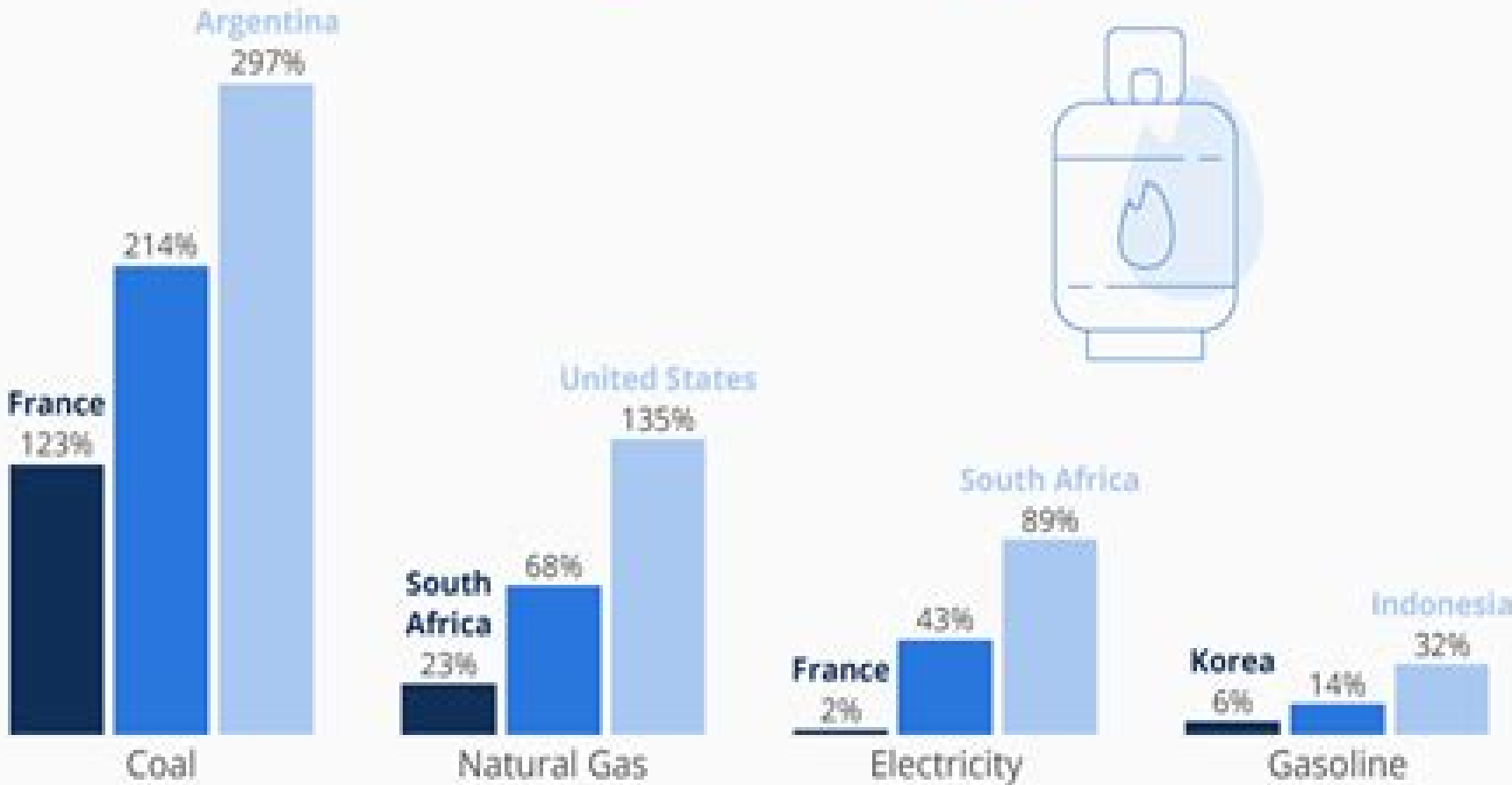


How Would a Carbon Tax Impact Energy Bills
