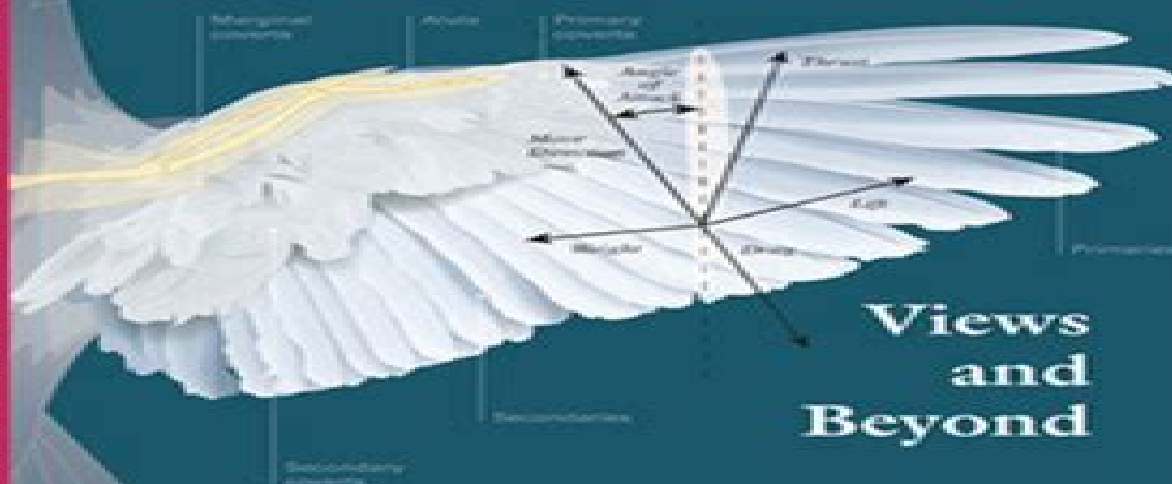

Details of the approach include a method for choosing the most relevant views, standard templates for documenting views, and the information beyond them, and definitions of the templates' content. At about the same time, the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE) was developing a recommended best practice for describing architectures for software intensive systems, ANSI/IEEE Std 1471-2000. Like V B, that standard takes a multi-view approach to the task of architecture documentation and it establishes a conceptual framework for architectural description and defines the content of an architectural description. This technical note summarizes the two approaches and shows how a software architecture document prepared using the V B approach can be made compliant with Std 1471-2000.
